Since <u>the last surrogacy update</u> the most important case in the world of surrogacy has been the President's decision in <u>Re X (A Child) (Surrogacy: Time limit)</u> [2014] EWHC 3135 (Fam). The decision has been welcomed by commissioning parents, academics and lawyers as constituting a common sense approach to some of the more rigid aspects of the statutory framework that governs surrogacy in this jurisdiction.

This update will look at *Re X* in detail and consider what we can expect from future cases in light of this landmark decision.
