

Michael Edwards instructed to represent the UK Health Security Agency in the UK Covid-19 Inquiry.

The UK Covid-19 Inquiry, which began on 28 June 2022, has been set up to examine the UK's response to and impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and learn lessons for the future. The Inquiry's work is guided by its Terms of Reference.

The inquiry investigations have been organised into Modules, and throughout each, the Inquiry hears evidence from witnesses, experts and Core Participants through a series of corresponding hearings.

Michael Edwards will be working on Module 5 (procurement – looking at the procurement and distribution of key healthcare supplies) and Module 7 (test, trace, and isolate – looking at the effectiveness of the strategy put in place by the UK Government). Both Modules are listed for hearings in 2025.
